Consultation, technique and aftercare

CONSULTATION AND PLANNING

GP referral

REQUIRED FIRST STEP

The published pathway requires a GP referral before cosmetic surgery.

2 consultations

BEFORE COSMETIC SURGERY

The consultation process is designed to support informed decision-making.

SAP

SELECTIVE ANATOMIC PRESERVATION

Planning is tailored to individual anatomy and the area being considered.

Anaesthetic

PUBLISHED OPTIONS

Local tumescent anaesthetic with light oral sedation, or general anaesthesia with an anaesthetist.

PROCEDURE AND AFTERCARE

Labia minora

PLANNING AREA

May be considered as part of individual treatment planning.

Labia majora

PLANNING AREA

May be considered as part of individual treatment planning.

Clitoral hood

PLANNING AREA

May be considered as part of individual treatment planning.

Alternatives

DISCUSSED

Alternatives and the option not to proceed form part of consultation.

Aftercare

FOLLOW-UP

Aftercare and follow-up are included in the published patient pathway.

Recovery

INDIVIDUAL

Your practitioner provides instructions relevant to the procedure and your circumstances.
